NO FLIGHT, AND IT'S THIRD TIME UNLUCKY FOR THEM

KUALA LUMPUR, Wed.

— It was third time unlucky for two English girls who were supposed to leave last night on a chartered flight to London.

Miss Ruth Cottingham, 23, and her friend, Miss Kathryn Greensill, 23, together with 148 other passengers were told that their long-awaited flight was again postponed.

Instead, a group of 150 Greeks returning from Australia, who had no Malaysian visas, left on their flight.

An agitated Miss Cottingham said today they booked their tickets in Hong Kong in May through the Inter-Asia Travel Agency branch there.

"At first we were to leave on August 28, but we were told by the agency's branch here

that it was postponed for the next day," she said.

This morning about 30 of them had gone to the agency's office in Bukit Bintang to demand a refund on their fare but were refused because the agency had already paid the money to the airline.

Their group was supposed to leave on Aug. 28 and the one from Australia on Aug. 31 but the two flights were postponed to Sept. 1 and 3 respectively.

This was due to "operational delays" on the part of the airline.

The chartered flight could only take 155 passengers and as the Greek migrants had no visas it was imperative that they continued on their way after a 72-hour stay. The Greeks arrived here on Aug. 31 evening.

300 in row over flight mess-up

KUALA LUMPUR, Tues.

—More than 300 chartered flight passengers at Subang airport tonight expressed indignation and disgust when they were told that their long-awaited flight might yet again be postponed.

The passengers, originally scheduled to leave in two groups on Aug. 28 and 31, have been told by Inter-Asia and Travel House that their flight would definitely be leaving tonight.

When they gathered at the airport at 8 tonight, it was discovered that they and another group of travellers were booked on one plane which could only accommodate half the number.

An argument ensued as to which group should leave first.

To make matters worse. 150 Greek migrants from Australia were also put on the same flight. As these migrants had no visas, it was imperative that they continued on their way after a 72-hour stay.

One particularly indignant passenger, Mr. Philip Khoo, blamed the travel agencies for the mess-up.

"They pile up reservations that were made months ago and cancel flights like nobody's business," he said angrily.

Most of the passengers were students leaving for studies overseas and had to register before Sept. 5. They could not



Why the delay in that charter flight to London

KUALA LUMPUR, Tues. — The recent eight-day delay of a Trans Polar charter flight arranged by the Inter Asia Travel Agency was today described as "abnormal".

normal".

The vice-president of the Trans
Polar Airlines, Mr. Eric Sandeberg,
said the flight was delayed because the
airlines had been refused landing
rights in London.

"And inspite of our trying des-

"And inspite of our trying desperately hard we were unable to secure landing rights or sub-charter another aircraft while the passengers were waiting," he added.

In the circumstances, the Inter Asia Travel Agency had had no choice but to postpone the flight and subject the passengers to inconvenience.

"We apologise on the behalf of Trans Polar as well as ourselves, for the inconvenience caused, and also in advance, for the inconvenience that will be caused to about 400 passengers who are booked on charter flights over

who are booked on charter flights over the next two weeks." Mr. Peter Chan, managing director of Inter Asia

He said the situation was "the worst we've experienced in our past three years of operation, during which we have handled more than 250 charter flights.

The best

"However, we have done our best to make our pas-sengers comfortable in hotels and give them meals at our expense, and this is all we can do in the cir-cumstances," he added.

Mr. Sandeberg said charter flight companies faced many problems.

"And the public must-remember that when they book on a chartered flight, they pay about a third of the price on a commercial flight. They must therefore be prepared for any diffi-culties and inconveniences that might occur." Mr.Sandeberg said.

"But I only hope that I don't end up in London at 2 a.m. as I live in Swindon, a good 70 miles from London," he added, before leaving on the flight — 32 hours behind schedule.
